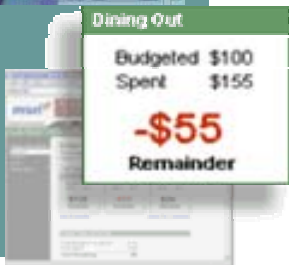
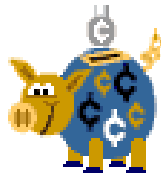
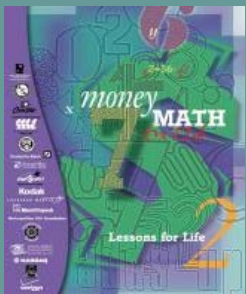

What Is Money Smart?

- Joint financial education initiative developed by the U.S. Department of Labor and the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC).
- Financial education that's free of charge and now available in your community.
- Services offered at local JobLink Career Centers.



Purpose of Money Smart

- Offers financial education to JobLink customers.
- Designed to prepare workers for a secure future.
- Designed to build financial knowledge and develop positive relationships with financial institutions.

How Does It Work?

- Consists of 10 modules covering basic financial education topics.
- Modules are taught in one hour formats.
- Classes are free.



Ten Training Modules

- Bank On It—Teaches the basics of banking services
- Borrowing Basics—Introduction to understanding credit
- Check It Out—Opening and maintaining a checking account.
- Money Matters—Preparing a personal budget
- Pay Yourself First—Importance, benefits and methods for saving money
